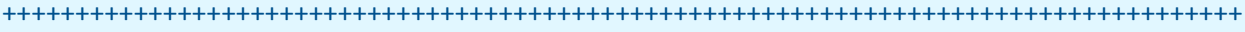

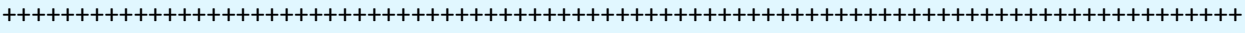

The Meriwether County 4-H Club and Hendricks Animal Clinic will host a



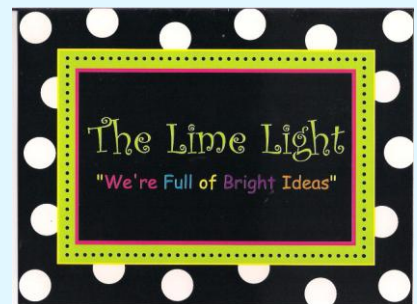
Rabies Clinic on Saturday April 12 - 11AM-12 Noon at Manchester Farm Garden & Hardware. One year
