- Be prepared with pen and paper by the phone no business caller likes to wait while you search for something to write with or on
- Take accurate messages read it all back for verification

- Transfer calls promptly and explain any delays if you have to place a caller on hold.
- Put a smile on your face and enthusiasm in your voice when you answer the phone
- Remember- the caller at the other end of the line is forming an impression of your entire company by the way you answer the phone - make it a good one!

Georgia Revenue up 5.2% over previous year....As Georgia

closed out the 2014 fiscal year at the end of June, tax collections were up from those of the previous year. Aided by an 11.5% increase in June's monthly collections over the same month of 2013 provided the final boost to the fiscal year. At the beginning of the fiscal year, there was \$717 million in the state's reserves, although the final tally for the new surplus won't be complete for a few more months.
